



WHERE CAN WE READ THE BIBLE?

BIBLE VERSE: For the word of God is living and effective and sharper than any double-edged sword, penetrating as far as the separation of soul and spirit, joints and marrow.
Hebrews 4:12

BONUS VERSE: So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you. Seek, and you will find. Knock, and the door will be opened to you. *Luke 11:9*

BIBLE STORY: Josiah and the Lost Scroll (2 Kings 22–23)

BIBLE TRUTH: We can read the Bible anywhere. We should obey God’s Word because He made us, He loves us, and His plans are good.

At TeamKID this week, your child learned that we can read the Bible anywhere and that we should obey His Word because He made us, loves us, and His plans for us are good. It’s so easy to get into our daily routines without the reading of God’s Word. We live in a world that beckons us to fill every moment of every day with something—and that is no mistake! The enemy wants us to be distracted from what really matters: our relationship with God.

Your child saw that this week in the story of Josiah. Josiah was a king who had lost sight of God’s Word. However, when a scroll was found in the temple, Josiah heard the words of God’s law. He was reminded of the commands God had given His people. Josiah made a promise to follow God once again and to lead His people to do the same.

As a leader in your household, you have the opportunity to use this story as a biblical example. Whether Bible reading is a normal part of your family’s routine or whether it has taken the back burner, it’s never too late to add even more time in Scripture to your schedule. Reinforce to your child this week that Bible reading is something we can do anywhere at any time so that we can best live within God’s good plans for us. As your family continues in daily routines, the habit of Bible reading can only enhance your goals, productivity, relationships with one another, and most importantly, your relationship with Jesus.
